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Eurodyn 2011 Exhibition Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions make up an agreement between TI-KVIV, Desguinlei 214, B-2018 Antwerpen, Belgium, represented by Rita Peys, conference manager, hereinafter called the "organizer", and the company whose name and representative is specified in the subscription form, hereinafter called the "exhibitor".

1. The rental fee includes: separation panels, carpet and furniture (2 tables, 3 chairs, 3 spots), electricity (220V, 50Hz, max 16A, Belgian plugs), wireless internet, conference participation including the CD-ROM proceedings for one delegate, and a night watchman on 4 July 2011 and 5 July 2011 from 6pm till 8am. VAT and equipment insurance are not included in the rental fee.
2. The allocation of the booths will be made on a first come, first served basis. Optionally, two adjacent booths can be combined to one larger booth. All stands will be assigned by the organizer. Assigned stands are not allowed to be subleased or remitted.
3. During the opening hours of the conference, the stands must be opened, illuminated, and accessible to the conference participants. When an exhibitor does not occupy the stand assigned to him at the opening of the exhibition, the organizer can use the space as he deems necessary. All material has to be removed from the exhibition room by Wednesday 6 July 17h00.
4. The weight of the material to be exhibited is limited to 200 kg/m². Fastening of objects to floor, ceiling or walls is not permitted. The Exhibitor is required to provide his own staff for the loading, handling and assembly of exhibits and associated materials. The organizer cannot provide staff for these purposes.
5. Payment should be received within 30 days of receiving the invoice. In case of non-payment within the stipulated period, the organizer reserves the right to resell the reserved booth, while the exhibitor shall remain committed to pay the full exhibition fee. No reimbursement will be made, other than specified under 8. below.
6. The exhibitor will indemnify the organizer for any claim or claims for damages against the organizer, resulting from any action or negligence on the part of the exhibitor or his representatives. The organizer is not responsible for losses and/or damages to any property of the exhibitor unless in the event of wilfull intent of the organizer; all goods and material placed in the exhibition building will remain there at the exhibitor's own risk. The exhibitor himself insures his material and his responsibility resulting therefrom. The organizer cannot be held responsible for damage liabilities due to fire or water damage or any other reason beyond their control as a result of the building being partly or completely out of service. To the extent that the liability of the organizer can be limited pursuant to applicable law, the maximum liability of the organizer shall amount to the total costs paid by the exhibitor under this Agreement.
7. The exhibitor will reimburse all costs for repairs to the building or the accessories made necessary through damage caused by himself, his employees, agents or representatives.
8. The exhibitor renounces the right to any financial claim if for any reason it should prove necessary to postpone or cancel the exhibition. In case of cancellation, however, the money already paid will be reimbursed to the exhibitor minus the expenses already incurred by the organizer.
9. The organizer cannot accept any liability for death, injury, or any loss, cost or expense suffered or incurred by any person if such loss is caused or results from the act, default or omission of any person other than an employee or agent of the organizer. In particular, the organizer cannot accept any liability for losses arising from the provision or non-provision of services provided by hotel companies or transport operators. Neither can the organizer accept liability for losses suffered by reason of war including threat of war, riot and civil strife, terrorist activity, natural disaster, weather, flood, drought, technical, mechanical or electrical breakdown, industrial disputes, governmental action, regulations or technical problems which may affect the services provided in connection with the conference.
10. The exhibitor is encouraged to make his own arrangements for health and travel insurance. The organizer cannot be held responsible for any personal injury, loss, damage, accident to private property or additional expenses incurred as a result of delays or changes in air, rail, sea, road or other services, strikes, sickness, weather or any other cause.
11. The exhibitor agrees to follow the organizer's reasonable instructions, including those given by authorized organizer staff at the exhibition room regarding matters of safety and security.
12. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of Belgium. Only the courts of Leuven, Belgium shall have jurisdiction should any dispute arise between exhibitor and organizer.
